## Earn Your Degree Anytime and Anywhere

Founded in 1970, Walden is an accredited university with a proud history of serving the education needs of the military. By providing broad access to quality higher education through online learning, Walden has become the choice for more than 2,400 veterans and active-duty servicemembers.

## Active-Duty Military and Veterans Benefits

If you are currently serving in the U.S. military, or if you are a military veteran or an employee of the Department of Veterans Affairs, Walden offers you a 15% tuition reduction.† Walden also honors the following education benefits for active-duty servicemembers, reservists, and veterans of the armed forces:

- **The Montgomery GI Bill (MGIB)** reimburses tuition costs through an education assistance allowance.
- **The Post-9/11 GI Bill** applies direct funds to cover a portion of costs for tuition, fees, and books.
- **Tuition Assistance** gives a portion of funds to cover costs of tuition and fees. This program is sponsored by the specific branch of the military you serve.
- **Tuition Assistance Top-Up** provides the remaining funds for tuition costs that are not covered under the Tuition Assistance program.
- **The VA Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Program** offers benefits to veterans with service-connected disabilities.
- **The Yellow Ribbon GI Education Enhancement Program** covers tuition costs that have not been applied under the Post-9/11 GI Bill.\*
