One semester credit equals 1.5 quarter credits. Quarter credit equivalencies are shown.

To be transferrable, core social work courses must meet these requirements:  
taken at a CSWE accredited institution within the last 6 years with a grade minimum of B.  
A **minimum of 45 quarter credits** must be earned at Walden.
