GRADUATION

YOUR LOAN DEBT

You must repay money that you borrow as student loans to pay for this program, including interest. LOAN NONPAYMENT STATISTICS

Walden's 3-year federal Cohort Default Rate (number of students who have defaulted on, or failed to repay, their loans) is 7.5% for FY 2014 using the 2013-2014 cohort. Massachusetts regulations require Walden to provide prospective students with a separate 'Loan Nonpayment Statistic', which is the sum of the Cohort Default Rate and students who are in deferral and forbearance. Therefore, using the Massachusetts calculation, Walden's "Loan Nonpayment Statistic" for 2013-2014 is 53.6%. Please note that this 'failed to repay' calculation includes students who may not currently be required to repay their loans, such as those who are in deferral and forbearance, which means they are not in default per federal financial aid guidelines, which is why it is Walden's position that the 7.5% federal Cohort Default Rate is a more accurate representation of our student's loan repayment rate.

PLACEMENT RATES AND EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

Massachusetts regulations require that a school who offers any occupational programs must disclose the graduation placement rate of graduates during the last two calendar years who obtained full time, non-temporary jobs in their field of study, and total placement rate of students that enrolled in the program during the last two calendar years who obtained full time, non-temporary jobs in their field of study. Walden has not tracked and is not required by its accreditor, the Higher Learning Commission, to track such rates. More than 87% of Walden's students are in graduate degree programs, and 77% of our students are already working full time at the time of their enrollment in the university (the majority in their field of study).ⁱ

EXAM COSTS

While Walden does not require an exam to enter, continue with, or graduate from a program, in order to obtain certification or licensure upon graduation from some programs, graduates will need to pass the appropriate state professional licensing exam. To the best of our knowledge, the table below reflects the applicable exam costs in the state of Massachusetts as of May 9, 2018:
