This transfer admission guarantee (TAG) agreement is between Jersey College and Walden University.

In order to qualify for the TAG Agreement, Jersey College students must graduate with an associate's degree in Nursing (**NOTE: A degree in Practical Nursing is not eligible for Admission**) with a cumulative GPA of 2.5, and successfully complete the courses indicated in the tables below with a 2.0 or higher, in addition to meeting the requirements for admission to Walden's RN-MSN program. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

Important Notes:

- Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit.
- Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.
- Applicants must have an active registered nurse (RN) license in the United States or its territories. International nurses must have the equivalent of a RN license in their home country.
