

## Overpayment of Federal Funds

According to the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) you have received one or more overpayments of federal student aid funds.

You are **required by law** to repay any federal student aid funds received for which you were not entitled.

To resolve your specific overpayment (Federal Pell Grant, SEOG Grant, Perkins, ACG Grant, SMART Grant, Iraq/Afghanistan Service Grant, or Teach Grant), you must contact either the Department of Education at 1-800-621-3115 or your prior school to obtain a Title IV Eligibility letter.

The Overpayment Title IV Eligibility letter **MUST** state that your overpayment is either paid in full or in a satisfactory payment arrangement.

Once you receive your overpayment clearance letter, please submit it to the Office of Financial Aid for review.

\*\*\*\* Please note that the Office of Financial Aid cannot request this letter for you. Also, the Office of Financial Aid cannot accept verbal verification of your overpayment status. We must have written documentation of the resolved overpayment status from the Department of Education or the school in which you received the overpayment. \*\*\*\*
