- The living allowance is based on national economic data that reflects housing, food, transportation, personal and internet costs associated with time in school for working adults. The amount is based on weeks enrolled in the 52-week academic year and will be reduced if the students academic year is shorter than 52-weeks.
- If there is an overlapping loan with another school, Walden will remove the indirect costs for the overlapping period.
