Name Change/Correction Form

If your name has changed while you are receiving federal financial aid at Walden University, you must inform Financial Services so we can update our records. You must use your legal name as shown on your birth certificate/name change court document (not a nickname) when applying for federal financial aid funds. This form will also be used for any name discrepancies Financial Services discovers while processing your federal financial aid funds. Your name must be updated on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®). In addition; you must also update your name with all loan servicers, lenders, and guarantors with whom you may have student loan records.

To change/correct your name with Financial Services you must complete the following steps:

You must submit a copy of your social security card (showing your correct legal first and last name). Walden University CANNOT process your name correction if you have not updated the Social Security Administration of your name change.
You must submit documentation showing the reason for the name change; such as marriage certificate, divorce papers or other court-approved documentation.
Please submit this form, along with your handwritten signature at the bottom, giving the Financial Services permission to correct your name on your FAFSA.
Financial Services will report your name correction directly to the Office of the Registrar. You must use your legal first and last name consistently on all documents and with all departments within Walden University.
